



A new book is now available on Father Capodanno's life. It was written by Monsignor Stephen DiGiovanni and is titled Armed with Faith: The Life of Father Vincent R. Capodanno, MM. The book draws on the information that was discovered during the Diocesan phase of the canonization process. The documentation of this information, or Acta (Acts) has been submitted to the Congregation for the Causes of Saints in Rome.
